Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Sandy Lake Borough

Our water system violated a drinking water standard over the past year. Even though this was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct this situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the monitoring period of May 1, 2018 thru May 31, 2018 we failed to collect one of two required samples for Total Coliform Bacteria and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for these contaminants and how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken and the date on which follow-up samples were or will be taken.

Corrective Action Taken: The one of two samples were not taken during May of 2018. Once we were made aware of the problem, we began monitoring activities for the contaminant.
